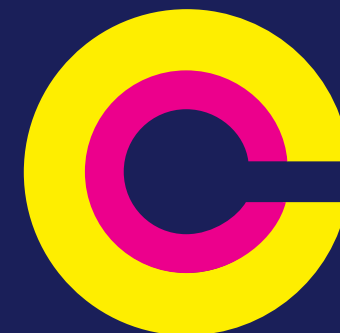

Jim Roseveare is a member of the Royal Society of Sculptors. His thirty or so years experience of working as an arboriculturalist means he has an everyday awareness of the ways humans relate to nature. Managing and interacting with trees has given him an intense consciousness of the relationship between nature and culture. More than that, it has enabled him to ponder time on a large scale and to be acutely aware of impermanence. Human technologies, extraction processes and materials manufacture have developed to provide us with the notion that we are in control of the natural world ... but ultimately all of our dabbings inevitably decay, fall into ruins and return to the earth.

He sees tree surgery itself as an, albeit more utilitarian, form of sculpture that runs in tandem with the constantly changing cycles of growth, dormancy, decline and decay. His work is a form of dance that like a sheepdog herds the flock of mutability.

Roseveare's art incorporates concrete, organic materials and debris swept from surrounding ground surfaces. The very fact that this exhibition will not only be hosted in the gallery itself, but also in surrounding woodland, embodies the very core themes and concepts that have preoccupied the artist throughout his life.

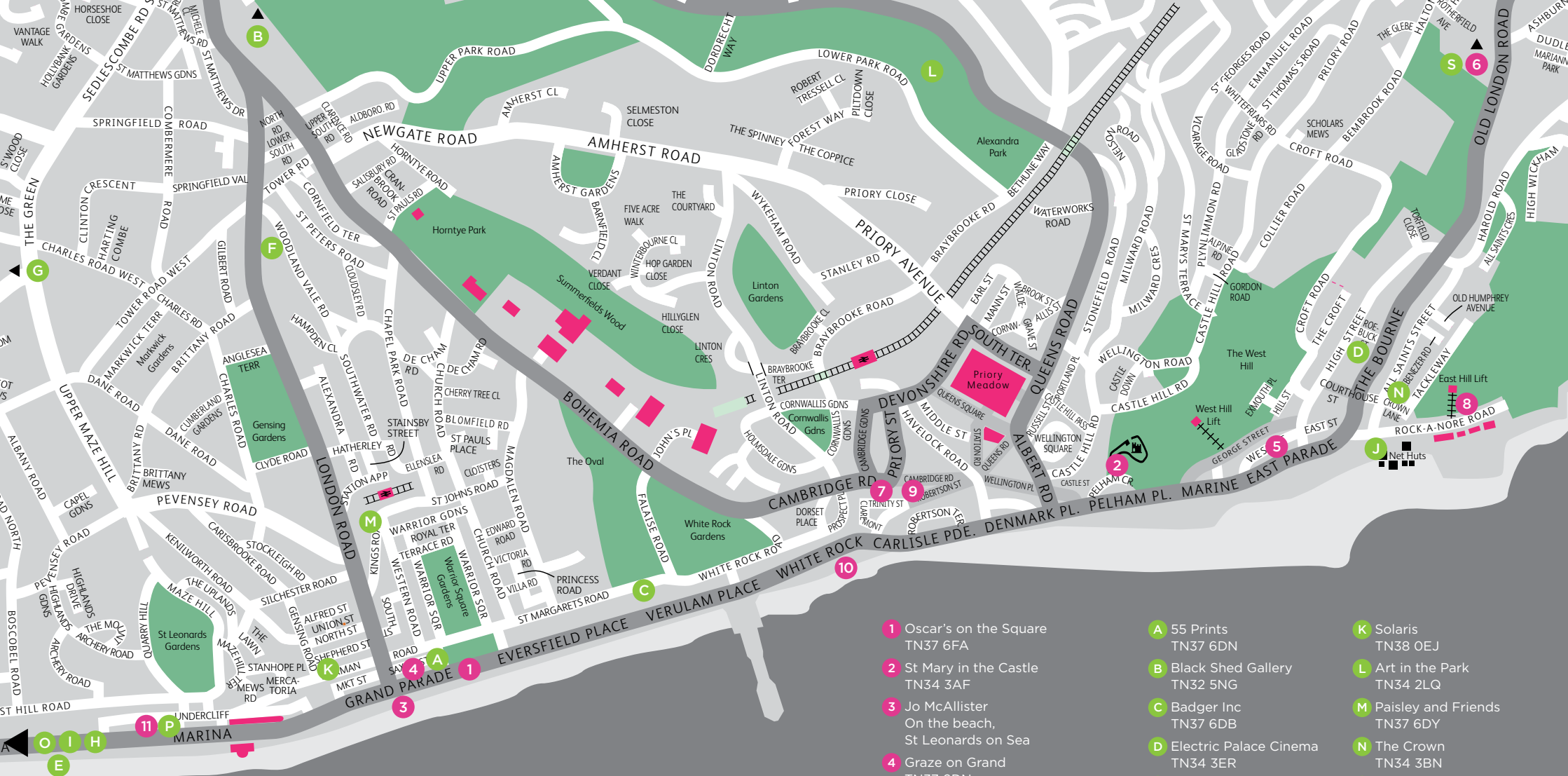

THE TIMEKEEPERS OF ETERNITY

On a redeye flight between Boston to LA, a group of strangers awake to the surreal discovery that the plane's crew and passengers have disappeared. Those that remain force an emergency landing to a nearby airport and find an outside world devoid of all life. Tensions mount as this cosmic anomaly tests the sanity of the passengers. All the while an ominous sound draws closer, suggesting an impending doom.

Born from the Stephen King novella The Langoliers - which was adapted into a 1995 TV movie - animator Aristotelis Maragkos painstakingly printed every frame of the movie to paper, reshaping it through black and white collage animation. Surreal distortions and reconstructions manifest the drama as literal tears and crinkles at the frame. The result is a film that uses its own form not only to express its unnerving narrative but to magnify the performance of its cast, and remain a supremely entertaining masterstroke of remix art.

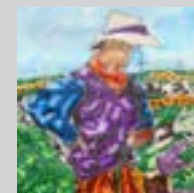

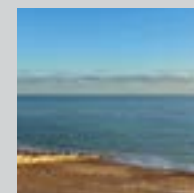

Rock Against Racism (1976-82) was the most vibrant grassroots cultural movement of the 20th century. Uniting music lovers to fight against racism and fascism, RAR harnessed the power of the imagination – thrilling music, electric graphic-art and witty, subversive polemic – along with a DIY ethos which enabled supporters to organise gigs and events within their local area, as part of a national and international collective effort.

Hundreds of local as well as established bands played RAR clubs, gigs and carnivals across Britain and the world. The result was a movement which raised the consciousness of a generation.
